As Chairman of the Tenth Congressional District Committee of the Republican Party of Virginia and pursuant to the Plan of Organization and as recommended and directed by the Committee, I, Chris Harnisch, do hereby issue this Call for a Mass Meeting to be held at Fairfax Christian School, 22870 Pacific Blvd, Sterling, VA 20166, starting at 10:00 a.m., with registration beginning at 8:30 a.m., on March 21, 2026 for the following purposes:

- a) Electing a Unit Chair;
- b) Electing 699 Members of the Unit Committee:
  - a. 597 Precinct Members
  - b. 102 At-Large Members;
- c) Electing up to 594 delegates and an equal number of alternate delegates to the Tenth District Convention, to be held on April 18, 2026 at Park Valley Church located at 4500 Waverly Farm Drive, Haymarket, Virginia, beginning at 10:00 a.m. for the purpose of electing a District Chairman;
- d) And for the transaction of such other business as may properly come before the Mass Meeting, which will not include considerations of any resolutions.

Qualifications for Participation

All citizens of the United States who are legal and qualified voters of Loudoun County under the laws of the Commonwealth of Virginia, regardless of race, religion, national origin or sex, who are in accord with the principles of the Republican Party, and who, if requested, express in open meeting either orally or in writing as may be required their intent to support all of its nominees for public office in the ensuing election may participate as members of the Republican Party of Virginia in its mass meetings, party canvasses, conventions, or primaries encompassing their respective election districts.

Participants will be required to make the statement of intent referenced above in writing, and to present a valid photo identification issued by the United States, the Commonwealth of Virginia, one of its political subdivisions, or a college or university located in the United States (expired identification is not valid).

Registration Fee

There will be a registration fee of \$20 to participate in the Mass Meeting. The registration fee may be paid in advance or at the meeting. Pre-registration to participate in the Mass Meeting is not required.

Candidate Filing Requirements

Candidates for election at the Mass Meeting must declare their candidacy in writing, using the attached official pre-filing form, or its online equivalent at [vagop10.org](http://vagop10.org), accompanied by a non-refundable filing fee in the amount listed in the following schedule, which must be received no later than the date listed in the following schedule:

*Filing Requirement Schedule*

- Unit Chair—\$1,000—5:00 p.m. on Sunday, March 15, 2026
- Unit Member—\$50—5:00 p.m. on Sunday, March 15, 2026
- Convention Delegate—\$25—5:00 p.m. on Sunday, March 15, 2026

Pre-filing is required. Nominations from the floor will not be in order.

Cancellation Provisions

If the number of persons filing as candidates for election or nomination does not exceed the number to be elected or nominated for a particular office, those persons shall be declared elected or nominated at the mass meeting or upon its cancellation.

If the number of persons filing as candidates for election or nomination for all offices does not exceed the number to be elected or nominated, the Mass Meeting will be cancelled.

Candidates for Unit Member will be assigned in order of receipt as candidates for precinct member until all precinct seats are filled, after which they will be considered candidates for at-large member. Only if more than 102 members are candidates for at-large member will an election be held.
